

Partnership: Reducing Barriers to Participation

DFC Academy (a registered ORA/For-Profit organization) & The Bradford Eagles Soccer Club (a registered Non-For Profit community club) have created an Alliance/partnership known as Union FC. The sole purpose is to promote participation in soccer of all levels to reduce barriers to participation. Both Club and Academy are a members of the Ontario Soccer Association and under the umbrella of the Canadian Soccer Association. BESC Club is governed by an elected Board of Directors and DFC Academy by Directors and an Advisory Committee. Union FC have taken the responsibility and role in which it will be governed by advisory group, a-making of both BESC and DFC members. This third party representatives will ensure neutrality and that both programs continue to provide more pathways and opportunities to the game of soccer, ensuring that every one of all levels can play and participate within the community. 


